LEGISLATION INTRODUCED INTO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ON 21 MARCH 2001

The following Bills were introduced into the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island on 21 March 2001:

- South Pacific Games Bill 2001:** This Bill makes certain necessary but temporary changes to administrative and legislative requirements during the period of the South Pacific Mini-Games when it will be necessary to depart from normal procedures for a defined period.

Sauth Pasifik Giems Bil 2001: Wan Bil f' wan Aekt f'mieket soe dat serten defrentor lor nor gwen' forset wailem Sauth Pasifik Mini-Giem haewenet orn Norf'k, en f'enithing aels mait afekt.
- Immigration (Guidelines) Amendment Bill 2001:** This Bill provides that the executive member, with the approval of the Legislative Assembly, may establish statutory guidelines for the management of immigration policy in Norfolk Island.

Im'grieshan (Gaidlains) Amenment Bil 2001: Wan Bil f' wan Aekt f'amen daa Im'grieshan Aekt 1980.
- Norfolk Island Broadcasting Authority Bill 2001:** This Bill established the Norfolk Island Broadcasting Authority and makes provision for the licensing, control, and regulation of both audio and visual broadcasting for the purposes of radio and television within the Territory of Norfolk Island and for related purposes.
