**LEGISLATION INTRODUCED INTO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ON 16 MAY 2001**

The following Bills were introduced into the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island on 16 May 2001:

**Appropriation Bill 2001:** This Bill is the formal adoption of the Norfolk Island Budget for the financial year ending 30 June 2002. The Bill is required for all expenditure from the Public Account under section 32A of the *Public Moneys Act 1979*.

**Statute Amendment (Gaming and Bookmakers) Bill 2001:**

This Bill arises from the advice and recommendation of the Norfolk Island Gaming Authority, after meetings and consultation with similar bodies in other jurisdictions. The current fee for a Gaming or Bookmakers licence in Norfolk Island is 250 fee units (\$3,750.00). This sum is manifestly inadequate, given that –

- considerable profits are possible for licensees;
- the standard fee in other jurisdictions is in the vicinity of \$50,000 to \$80,000;
- the fee of \$3,750.00 does not give adequate return to the community in exchange for the rights it endows.

Accordingly, the Minister has requested a Bill which increases the licence fees for both Gaming and Bookmaking to an appropriate level, and at the same time remains attractive for prospective investors in the industry within Norfolk Island. The Bill increases the fees to 2500 fee units (\$37,500.00).

Copies of the Bills are available free of charge from Mrs Jan Keeping at the Legal Services Unit of the Norfolk Island Administration. They may also be perused at the Public Library.
