**NORFOLK ISLAND
ELECTRICITY SUPPLY ACT 1985
NOTICE OF PROHIBITED ELECTRICAL ARTICLES**

I, Ronald Coane Nobbs, Chief Minister and Minister for Finance and Government Services, under subsection 26(1) of the Electricity Supply Act 1985 –

- (a) revoke the notices of prohibited electrical articles dated 27 August 1995; and
- (b) specify the electrical articles set out in Schedule 1 to be electrical articles that must not, after 31 May 2001 be sold, hired, installed, connected or used; and
- (c) specify the electrical articles set out in Schedule 2 to be electrical articles that must not, after 31 May 2001, be sold, hired, installed, connected or used unless the prior written approval of the Electricity Manager is obtained; and
- (d) state that this instrument shall come into operation on 31 May 2001.

NOTES

- 1 To avoid unnecessary expense, consumers are advised to apply on the forms available at the Administration Offices, Kingston, and ensure that appliances are approved before they are purchased.
- 2 If prohibited or unauthorised electrical articles are installed, connected or used, the consumer may, on conviction, be fined up to \$200.
- 3 Owners of appliances the use of which is prohibited by the above notice may apply to the Minister for Tourism and Finance for exemption from the operation of the notice.

HORSES IN PUBLIC RESERVES

The *Public Reserves Act 1997* prohibits persons from riding horses, or taking horses into public reserves unless otherwise approved by a plan of management or by the Conservator of Public Reserves.

On 25 March 1998 it was approved by notice in the Gazette, that horses may be ridden in those areas in public reserves to which cattle normally have access for grazing. Those areas include the fenced parts of reserves in which cattle grazing is managed, such as parts of Cascade Reserve adjacent to Cascade Road and Kingston Common Reserve between Country Road and Middlegate Road.

That approval means, for instance, that horses may be ridden or taken onto those parts of Kingston Common that are normally grazed by cattle, but may not be ridden or taken without a permit onto areas that cattle are not allowed to graze, such as the golf course.
