## **INTERPRETATION ACT 1979 NOTIFICATION OF FEE INCREASES**

Members of the Norfolk Island Community are advised that pursuant to the Retail Price Index formula contained in section 12B of the Interpretation Act 1979, all fees which are based on a fee unit have increased as from 1 July 2001.

The current fee unit of \$15.00 has automatically increased to \$16.50 in accordance with the legislative formula as follows –

$$137.0 \text{ (RPI increase March 2001)} \div 126.4 \text{ (RPI increase March 1999)} = 1.0838$$

$$1.0838 \text{ (increase factor) rounded up per section 12B(3)(b)} = 1.1$$

$$1.1 \times 15 \text{ (standard fee unit)} = \$16.50$$

A full list of new fees to which the fee unit applies is published in this Gazette in accordance with subsection 12B(4) of the Interpretation Act 1979.
