**PASTURAGE AND ENCLOSURE REGULATIONS**  
**REGULATION 5**

I, Allan John McCoy, Executive Member for Health and Environment, direct the owners of stock depastured under the Pasturage and Enclosure Act 1949, to muster the stock for drenching and inspection by the Stock Inspector at one of the following places between 7 a.m. and 3 p.m. on any of the dates indicated below for that area. Any variation of dates will be notified over the local radio.

**NOTICE FOR GENERAL INFORMATION**  
**STOCK HEALTH PROGRAMME**

Further to the executive member for Health and Environment's direction of 21 August 2001 under the Pasturage and Enclosure Regulations, it is advised that a calf up to the age of six months which is to be depastured with its mother, will be drenched and tagged at the same time as the mother and a fee of \$4-00 per calf charged for this service.

**Important Notice:**

Stock which receive treatment for internal parasites should not be slaughtered for consumption for thirty (30) days after receiving treatment.

Owners of stock depastured on common lands are advised that stocks are to receive medication for the control of copper deficiency. Stockowners should note that a right of pasturage will not be granted to any animal declared by the Stock Inspector to be a useless animal.

**CHARGES FOR MUSTERING STOCK**

**LEGISLATION INTRODUCED INTO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ON 15 AUGUST 2001**

The following Bill was introduced into the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island on 15 August 2001:

**Tourist Accommodation (Registration and Quota) Amendment (No. 2) Bill 2001:** This Bill amends the **Tourist Accommodation (Registration and Quota) Amendment Act** ('the principal Act') to ensure that the savings provisions in Section 8 of the principal Act include a category of tourist accommodation houses where owners have applied for and paid the fee for registration as a Tourist Accommodation House and where planning approval has been granted. The Bill is intended to be retrospective so that it can take effect at the same time as the commencement of the principal Act.

A copy of the Bill is available free of charge from Mrs Jan Keeping at the Legal Services Unit of the Norfolk Island Administration.
