REFERENDUM ACT 1964
REFERENDUM ON THE QUESTION

**‘Should a new election be held for the full membership of the Legislative Assembly
at the earliest convenience?’**

Under section 11 of the Referendum Act 1964, a group of electors who are in favour of the above question being adopted may submit a statement for the Speaker’s approval for distribution to the electors. Similarly, a group of electors who oppose the adoption of the above question may also submit a statement for the Speaker’s approval for distribution to the electors. The purpose of such statements is –

- a) to allow the presentation of arguments for and against the question to be put to each elector; and
- b) to allow each elector to make an independent and informed judgement on the question.

Statements for and statements against are now invited to be lodged. Those groups with common viewpoints should combine their statements so that there is only one statement for, and one statement against, to be circulated. Such statements must be submitted to the Speaker no later than Thursday 27 September 2001.

REFERENDUM ACT 1964
INSTRUMENT DIRECTING A REFERENDUM**

I, David Ernest Buffett, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, under section 5 of the Referendum Act 1964 and in accordance with a resolution of the Legislative Assembly, direct a referendum to ascertain the opinion of the electors on the question –

**‘Should a new election be held for the full membership of the Legislative Assembly
at the earliest convenience?’**

REFERENDUM ACT 1964

I, Michael Charles Elmore Evans, Returning Officer, hereby notify pursuant to section 9 of the Referendum Act 1964 that -

(a) the question on which the opinion of the electors is to be ascertained is -

**‘Should a new election be held for the full membership of the Legislative Assembly
at the earliest convenience?’**

(b) the method of voting on the question shall be by marking the ballot paper “YES” or “NO”;

(c) the day for closing the electoral roll is Wednesday 26 September 2001;

(d) the day for polling is Wednesday 24 October 2001; and

(e) the method by which votes shall be counted shall be in accordance with sections 21, 22 and 23 of the Referendum Act 1964.

LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ACT 1979
ELECTORAL ROLL**

ARE YOU ENROLLED ON THE ELECTORAL ROLL? If you are not enrolled, you will not be eligible to vote at the referendum to be held on Wednesday 24 October 2001.

Qualifications for enrolment, in summary, are as follows:

(a) you must have attained the age of 18 years; and

(b) you must have been present in Norfolk Island for a total of 900 days during the period of 4 years immediately preceding the date of application.

The roll will close at 5.00 pm on Wednesday 26 September 2001. Enrolment is compulsory.

If you are a student under the age of 25 years, and you have been absent from Norfolk Island for the sole or principal purpose of undergoing full-time vocational training or full-time education, you may qualify for enrolment.

Application forms for enrolment may be obtained at the Post Office and the Immigration Office at Kingston.

IMPORTANT REMINDER
HEADSTONE TIPS

The public are requested to **SORT THEIR REFUSE** before it is delivered to Headstone Tips. This will assist in ensuring a more efficient operation, and help control pollution of the surrounding foreshores.

REMEMBER

BOTTOM TIP: * **ONLY FOR HOUSEHOLD AND NON-COMBUSTIBLE REFUSE**

- Non-combustible material - deposit over chute.
- Combustible material - deposit into burning cage.
- Remove tops and lids of containers to ensure they sink.
- Separate pressure packs from other refuse.
- Burnt rubbish should be completely disintegrated into ash, before depositing over chute.
- Plastic bags containing combustibles and non-combustibles **MUST** be separated prior to entering burning cage.

TOP TIP: * **ONLY FOR COMBUSTIBLE GARDEN CLIPPINGS AND BUILDING MATERIALS**

- Non-combustible materials, (eg large tree trunks and stumps) - **WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
- **NOTE:** Disposable baby nappies and used clothing - deposit into burning pit.

Attendants will be present 7 days a week during opening hours at both tips, to assist members of the public, and to maintain safety standards.

Both Tips will be closed Christmas Day, Good Friday and Anniversary Day.
