LEGISLATION INTRODUCED INTO THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ON 26 SEPTEMBER 2001

The following Bill was introduced into the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island on 26 September 2001:

Employment (Public Holidays) Amendment Bill 2001:

Section 9 of the Employment Act 1988 determines the dates upon which public holidays are to be observed in Norfolk Island.

In the past, additional public holidays in respect of the Queen's Birthday and Show Day were determined by the executive member under subsection 40(1) of the Public Service Act 1979. This Bill rectifies an anomaly which has arisen with the repeal of the Public Service Act 1979 and it allows the executive member to continue to determine public holidays in respect of the Queen's Birthday and Show Day.

The Bill allows the executive member to make determinations under subsection 9(1) of the Employment Act 1988 so that matters relevant to the determination of public holidays will be comprehensively covered by the Employment Act 1988.

A copy of the Bill is available free of charge from Mrs Jan Keeping at the Legal Services Unit of the Norfolk Island Administration.
