NORFOLK ISLAND ACT 1979
DETERMINATION OF DATE FOR GENERAL ELECTION

I, Anthony John Messner, Administrator of Norfolk Island, acting under section 35(1) of the *Norfolk Island Act 1979* (Cth), determine that a general election of members of the Legislative Assembly is to be held on 29 November 2001.

NORFOLK ISLAND ACT 1979
QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELECTION

In accordance with sections 38 and 39 of the Norfolk Island Act 1979, a person is qualified to be a candidate for election as a member of the Legislative Assembly if, at the date of nomination, the person -

- (a) has attained the age of 18 years;
- (b) is entitled, or qualified to become entitled, to vote at elections of members of the Legislative Assembly; and
- (c) has been ordinarily resident within Norfolk Island for a period of 5 years immediately preceding the date of nomination.

A person is not qualified to be a candidate for election as a member of the Legislative Assembly if, at the date of nomination, the person -

- (a) is an undischarged bankrupt;
- (b) has been convicted and is under sentence of imprisonment for one year or longer for an offence against the law of the Commonwealth or of a State or Territory; or
- (c) is a member of the Police Force of Norfolk Island or of the Commonwealth.

LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ACT 1979
NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR ELECTION

The Administrator has determined 29 November 2001 to be the date for an election of members of the Legislative Assembly.

Under section 12 of the Legislative Assembly Act 1979, nomination day is -

The nomination of a candidate for election to the Legislative Assembly is to be effected by delivering to the Returning Officer, **not later than noon on nomination day**, a form in accordance with Form 1 in the Second Schedule to the Legislative Assembly Regulations, signed by the candidate and by at least 2 electors.
