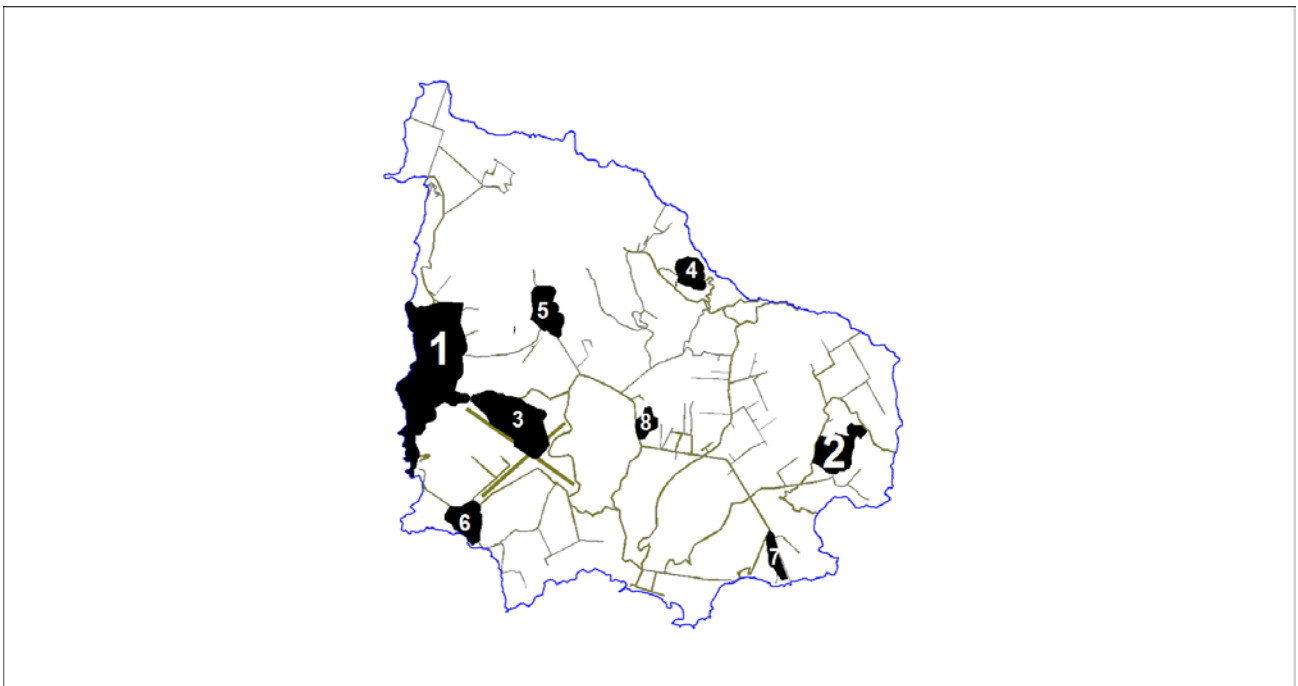


# CAUTION

## ARGENTINE ANTS

To keep Argentine ants from being spread around Norfolk, we ask please to inspect any materials including firewood, green waste, building materials etc. from these Argentine ant hotspots before removal.



1. Headstone through to Puppy's Point – St Barnabas' Chapel through to Mission Rd
2. Hibiscus Drive – entire area between Martins Rd, Stockyard Rd and Two Chimneys Rd
3. Waste management to Douglas Drive down to St Barnabas' chapel
4. Prince Philip Drive
5. Mt Pitt Rd
6. Rocky Point
7. Collins Head Rd –corner of Driver Christian Rd to the end of Collins Head Rd (right side only)
8. Burnt Pine – valley area behind RSL

Zones 1 and 2 are highly infested with a high priority for baiting. Please do not remove any materials from these areas unless inspected by the Argentine Ant Eradication Program team.

Zone 3 being the waste management centre; please inspect all materials thoroughly before removal.

Zones 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 are in the eradication stages with numerous yearly baiting showing positive results leading to eradication of those areas. We still ask to inspect all materials being removed.
