



DRAFT REVISED DEVELOPMENT CONTROL PLAN NO. 2 WATER RESOURCES

How to make a Submission

Any person is entitled to make a submission to comment on the draft development control plan. The purpose of the public exhibition of the draft development control plan is to seek public opinion about the draft plan. You might want to express your support for the draft plan or object to the draft plan or specific provisions of the draft plan. If you object to the draft development control plan or specific provisions within the draft plan the grounds for objection must be specified in the submission.

Public Exhibition period & closing date for submissions

The draft development control plan is available for inspection between Monday 2 August 2021 and Monday 30 August 2021. The draft plan can be viewed at 'Documents on public exhibition' at Council's website <http://www.norfolkisland.gov.nf/your-council/council-documents/documents-public-exhibition> and hard copies are available at Customer Care and the Planning and Building Office at Kingston.

Submission requirements

Submissions must be made in writing (email is acceptable) and delivered to the Council by

1. Email to planning@nirc.gov.nf; or
2. Post to the General Manager, PO Box 95 Norfolk Island 2899; or
3. Hand delivery to Customer Care.

All submissions must reference as the subject 'Submission - Draft Revised DCP 2 Water Resources'.

Submissions must clearly indicate the names, postal address or e-mail of person(s) making the submission.
