SECOND ASSEMBLY

WEDNESDAY 15 DECEMBER 1982

1 The Assembly met at 2.02 p.m. Mr. President (Honourable D.E. Buffett) took the Chair and read the Prayer.

2 BUSINESS

Mr. Sanders (Executive Member for Planning, Tourism and Commerce) moved -

"That this meeting of the House should not deal with any business other than condolences, Notice No. 1, the next day of sitting and the adjournment".

Question put.
Motion agreed unanimously.

3 CONDOLENCES

Mr. Sanders (Deputy President) referred to the death of -

As a mark of respect to the memory of the deceased all Members stood in silence.

4 REFERENDUM

Mr. Sanders (Executive Member for Planning, Tourism and Commerce), pursuant to notice, moved -

"That consequent upon acceptance of the cumulative system of voting at the Referendum of 1st December 1982, this House is of the opinion that:

- (a) a Referendum should be held to ascertain whether the Norfolk Island community wishes to immediately have a general election under the new cumulative system of voting; and
- (b) the question to be asked at such a Referendum should be 'Do you want an election for a new legislative Assembly to be called immediately'."

Debate ensued.
Question put.
Motion agreed unanimously.

Mrs Gray moved -

"That this House, at its rising, adjourn until Wednesday
2 February 1983 at 2 p.m."

Question put.
Motion agreed unanimously.

6 ADJOURNMENT

Miss Buffett moved -

"That the House do now adjourn".
