Minister thanks community for “marvellous response”

The Minister for the Environment, the Hon Stephanie Jack MLA, has thanked the members of the community who attended consultations with her at the Legislative Assembly this week. She said that those who attended had engaged in vigorous and constructive discussion on the important issues facing Norfolk Island.

“The response was truly marvellous”, Mrs Jack said. “Around 50 people chosen randomly from the electoral roll attended the sessions and made their views known. The information given will be of great help to me as part of the Norfolk Island Government as we enter into a process of dialogue with the Commonwealth about the substantial changes it is proposing for our community”.

Mrs Jack said that she would be conducting another series of similar consultations no later than early April.
