Special Norfolk Air freight service

The Chief Minister of Norfolk Island, David Buffett, has announced that Norfolk Air will operate a special service for air freight on Monday 19th February 2007.

“There has been some accumulation of air freight in Australia over recent weeks due to a range of circumstances”, Mr Buffett said. “Factors involved have included inclement weather, high air freight demand due to the longer than usual gap between sea services and high passenger numbers on many incoming flights. The Government has therefore decided to underwrite a one-off cargo flight to clear all freight backlog from Australia”.

The Chief Minister said that the aircraft is due to depart Norfolk Island at approximately 7.00 a.m. on Monday and is expected to return around 1.00 p.m.
