



NorfolkAir super special deal to Newcastle

NorfolkAir today announced a super special one-way deal for Norfolk Islanders wishing to travel on the inaugural service to Newcastle on Monday 7 May. Tickets from Norfolk to Newcastle are now on sale at just \$89.00 plus taxes.

NorfolkAir General Manager Ewan Wilson said that there had been excellent demand for tickets from Newcastle and surrounding regions, but that there were still seats available on the first flight due to leave Norfolk Island at 9.00 a.m. on Monday 7 May, subject to regulatory approval. He said that Australian authorities required a proving flight, which would leave Norfolk Island on April 30 and return May 1. This flight was effectively a trial run to ensure that all aspects of the operation were in order, including handling of passengers and baggage.

“Everything is in readiness for our Newcastle service”, Mr Wilson said. “There is much enthusiasm in Newcastle, which welcomes the return of international services to its excellent upgraded airport. There will be a traditional welcome for the aircraft when it arrives along with other celebrations. This very affordable fare will give Norfolk Islanders the chance to go to Newcastle and join in the excitement”.

NorfolkAir is offering the super special for just the inaugural flight, with return travel available at normal fares from Newcastle, Sydney or Brisbane. Tickets are now available at Burnt Pine Travel and Norfolk Travelworld.
