New arrangements strengthen business relationship between Norfolk Air and OzJet

The Norfolk Island Government today expressed its gratitude to OzJet Airlines in relation to revisions to their mutual business arrangements. In recent negotiations, OzJet agreed to reduce its weekly charter fees during the traditional winter low season. This will ease cost pressures and ensure that the full advertised schedule of return services to Australian destinations (Sydney, Brisbane and Newcastle) will continue.

Norfolk Air has offered a number of special fares to the public and to wholesalers during the low season, resulting in a steady flow of bookings which will assist in reducing the trough in visitor numbers usually experienced between mid-June and the end of August.

As part of the maturing of the five-year contract for air services between Norfolk Air and OzJet, the Norfolk Island Government also agreed to post a fully-repayable bond as a good faith sign of its confidence in the strengthening of the mutual commercial ties, with a view to continuing the strong growth in visitor numbers, which have now risen for each of the past 13 months.
