School trees to be trimmed

The Executive Director, Environment and Infrastructure of the Administration of Norfolk Island, Peter Davidson, said today that during the past two months a number of limbs had broken from the larger trees in the school grounds - especially in some of the high winds recently experienced.

Mr Davidson said that the Works Manager and staff had arranged to use a cherry picker next week to assist with trimming these trees, some of which needed quite heavy pruning to ensure the ongoing safety of students, parents and staff at the school.

Mr Davidson said that it was planned that all of the necessary work would be completed next week, before the end of the school holidays.
