#### **GST Remittance Forms**

Minister for Finance Neville Christian said today that the recently revised GST Remittance Form had been withdrawn following complaints from businesses that it was misleading or difficult to complete.

Mr Christian said that the form would be redesigned and reissued shortly in a more user-friendly format. He said that the GST Office had sent email or postal advice to all registered businesses requesting that they use the old Remittance Form until the new one was issued.

“Some businesses have told me that the new form is fine, but to remove any confusion we will improve it to ensure that it meets the needs of all users,” Mr Christian said. “The Norfolk Island Government apologises to anyone who has been inconvenienced by this matter”.
