#### **Use of mobile phones while driving**

The public are reminded that the use of a mobile phone whilst driving on a public road is an offence under the *Road Traffic Act 1982*.

The only exemptions to this provision are for the police and emergency services.

Persons who wish to use a mobile phone whilst they are the driver of a vehicle should ensure that they have first parked the vehicle to avoid prosecution.
