Government Open day – November 17th

Chief Minister André Nobbs has invited all members of the Norfolk Island community to meet informally with representatives of the Norfolk Island Government and the Legislative Assembly at Rawson Hall on Saturday 17th November.

“We are holding another open day as part of our commitment to consulting with the community”, Mr Nobbs said. “This is another way that members of the public can raise issues or ask questions of Government and Assembly members face to face. The open day will come shortly after the November sitting of the Assembly, so we will be happy to elaborate on any matter raised there, or in fact on any issue about the community, economy and good governance of Norfolk Island”.

Mr Nobbs said that several Ministers and Members would be in attendance at Rawson Hall from 12 noon to 2.00 p.m. next Saturday, 17th November. Anyone not wishing to raise a question or issue publicly will be given the opportunity of a private meeting or of lodging a question in writing without necessarily having to disclose their name.
