



## **Norfolk Air Adds Booking Benefits for Groups**

Norfolk Air has announced important changes to its fare rules to make booking group travel to Norfolk Island easier and more affordable for wholesalers and travel agents.

From December 3 the ticketing deadline for Q and O class tickets will be extended from 72 hours to five days while non-refundable deposits for group travel will be reduced from 120 days to 90 days.

At the same time wholesalers will be permitted to change the names for group travellers in G class right up to departure time for payment of a fee of \$100 per change.

“These new fare rules offer travellers and ticketing agents considerable benefits and put Norfolk Air at the forefront of industry change,” said Norfolk Air General Manager Ewan Wilson.

Earlier this year Norfolk Air also added a button to its website [www.norfolkair.com](http://www.norfolkair.com) to enable travel agents to register and begin direct bookings for flights from each of the airlines Australian ports - Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne and Newcastle.
