### **MEDIA RELEASE:           Community Information Centre and Information Resource to open on Friday June 12**

On behalf of Norf'k CIRCA Inc., founder member André Nobbs has announced that the new facility for community information and resources will be opened on Friday 12 June at 3.00 p.m. The owners of the premises formerly known as 'Sidewalk Café' have generously made available part of their premises rent-free so that the centre can commence operation.

"It is very encouraging that there are generous members of the public who support the concept of a community information centre and this offer, together with the in-kind support of the Government in the provision of human resources, have given the centre a flying start", Mr Nobbs said.

Mr Nobbs reaffirmed that the purpose of this joint community and government collaboration, is to provide assistance for both local community members and those persons who visit the island to obtain updated information on services available and where and how to access information. The centre will also provide assistance concerning applications for funding, training or resources with both government and non-government organisations for eligible programmes within Norfolk Island.

The Association itself has been a recipient of such funding through the Foundation for Rural and Regional Renewal in the sum of \$4,000 for the purchase of software to provide a terminal so that persons can access appropriate websites.

All members of the community are invited to join CIRCA representatives and information network members at the official opening by the Chief Minister. Light refreshments will be served.

Members of the public are invited to join the Association (for which membership is free) and to provide data updates so that the information available both to our visitors and residents is current. It is not necessary to be a member of the Association to be able to use these facilities and it is intended that this will be a free community service. As part of its support for the new community information centre, the Norfolk Island Government has supplied the contact facilities and administrative support to signify its commitment to the ideals of the Association as outlined in its constitution.
