## PLANNING ACT 2002 DRAFT VARIATIONS TO THE NORFOLK ISLAND PLAN 2002

Application to for the following variations to the Norfolk Island Plan 2002 have been made to the executive member in accordance with the *Planning Act 2002* and are currently under consideration.

VAR 1-2005	Variation of schedule 2 of the Norfolk Island Plan 2002 to accommodate a proposed veterinary establishment and ancillary kennels on portion 43s5, off Cascade Road	Rural Residential
VAR 2-2005	Rezoning of portion 152a Mission Road from Conservation to Rural to correct a cartographic error.	Conservation

### **Public Exhibition**

The details of these proposed variations, including details of the proposed use or development of land for variation 1-2005, and reasons for the variations are available for inspection between 12 January 2005 and 8 February 2005. This information may be inspected, during business hours, at the Planning Office of the Land Use and Environment Branch of the Administration of Norfolk Island, No 11 Quality Row, Kingston.

### **Submissions**

Any person may, during the period between 12 January 2005 and 8 February 2005, make written submissions to the Chief Executive Officer about the proposed variations to the Norfolk Island Plan 2002 (draft Norfolk Island Plan 2002).

All submissions must state the relevant Variation number.

All submissions must be signed by at least one person making the submission.

If a submission objects to the proposed variations, the grounds for objection must be specified in the submission.
