KAVHA is the Kingston Arthur's Vale Historic Area on Norfolk Island. It is rich with cultural and historical significance for Norfolk Island and Australia and covers the pre-European, Polynesian occupation; two settlements during the convict era, referred to as the First and Second Penal Settlements, (1788-1814, 1825-1855); and the Pitcairn settlement (1856-present, incorporating the post 1945 settlement).

The KAVHA Film will be an informative, critical and artistic insight into KAVHA as a living cultural landscape.
