BILLS PRESENTED IN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ON 18 MAY 2005
THE FOLLOWING BILLS WERE PRESENTED:

Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2) Bill 2004-2005: This Bill authorises additional expenditure from the Public Account for the financial year ending 30 June 2005. The purpose of the additional expenditure of \$120,000 is to provide for medical expenses (overseas) and patient travel costs.

Appropriation Bill 2005-2006: This Bill authorises expenditure from the Public Account of \$12,589,800 during the financial year 2005-2006. Funding relates to salaries, wages, recurrent/operational expenditure and capital expenditure.

Airport (Amendment) Bill 2005: This Bill provides for an increase in landing charges for aircraft that at present are capped at 1.8 fee units (or \$32.40) or .8 fee units (or \$14.40) per 1000 kg of maximum take-off weight of aircraft, whichever is higher. The proposed increase will be to 3 fee units (or \$50.40) or 1.5 fee units (or \$27) per 1000kg of maximum take-off weight of aircraft, whichever is higher.
