**IMMIGRATION ACT 1980**

**Temporary Entry Permit Holders – Requirement to hold ticket for onward travel from Norfolk Island.**

The Immigration Section has introduced a system to allow the lodgment of a bond that will in some instances replace the requirement for Temporary Entry Permit holders to hold a ticket for onward travel from Norfolk Island. The system enables Temporary Entry Permit holders to lodge the bond with the Immigration Section at Customs House on the completion of initial Immigration formalities. The ticket holder will then be given an authorization to cash the ticket providing the ticket has no restrictions. The Temporary Entry Permit will be endorsed to indicate that there is no requirement to hold a ticket for onward travel. Permit holders who avail themselves of the facility will need to **have their permit readily available when traveling for presentation to airline check-in staff.**

The system will be available from 5 December 2005. Further information in respect to the facility can be obtained from the Immigration Officers at Customs House, Burnt Pine, telephone 22140 select 2.
