## LIQUOR ACT 2005

### DECLARATION OF DAYS ON WHICH LIQUOR MAY NOT BE SOLD

I, Timothy John Sheridan, Minister for Finance, under subsection 25(1) of the *Liquor Act 2005*, ("the Act") revoke any previous declaration under that section of the Act and declare the following days and parts of days to be days on which liquor may not be sold —

- Christmas Day
- Good Friday
- The parts of each above declared day before 60 minutes prior to service of a meal in licensed premises and after 90 minutes following service of such a meal with no takeaway liquor permitted.

Subsection 25(1) of the Act does not prevent the supply of liquor —

- (a) to a person as part of a bona fide meal, for which a charge (excluding the price of any liquor) of not less than \$10 is made, in a dining room or public area, of licensed premises; or
- (b) to a person who is a bona fide resident in the premises for consumption on the licensed premises by that person.

- All reports to be output developed must be able to print to a Microsoft Windows default printer;
- Vendor ability to enter a contract to include all pre-testing, implementation and training time-lines, plus maintenance and back-up support for an initial one month period;
- A vendor with proven capability to deliver specific software solutions and training on time and on budget.
