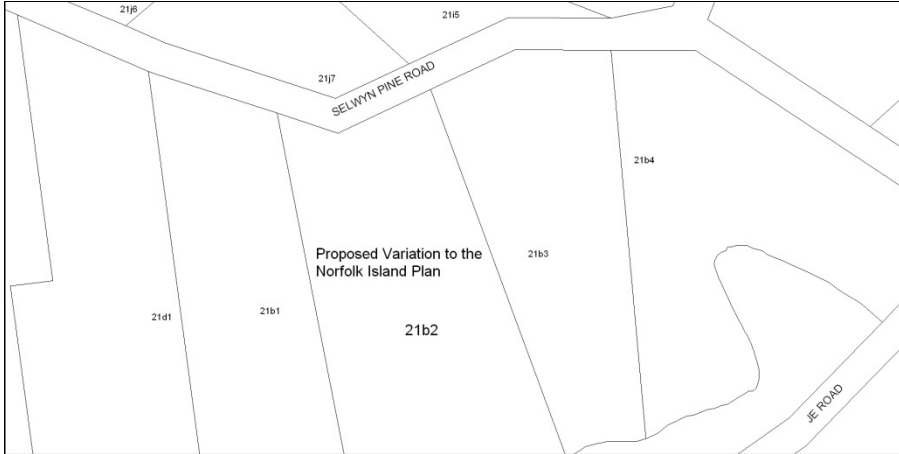

**PLANNING ACT 2002 – SUBSECTION 11(1) NOTICE
DRAFT PLAN**

I, Ronald J Ward, Minister for the Environment, give notice under section 11 of the *Planning Act 2002* ("the Act") of the following draft plan, prepared in accordance with section 9 of the Act.

Applicant: Ernest Christian
Draft Amendment to Norfolk Island Plan No: 14/01
Location and proposed amendment: Portion 21b2 Selwyn Pine Road, proposed to be subdivided into two portions, as described below.



A Development Application, accompanied by a Plan Variation Application, has been submitted to subdivide Portion 21b2 into two portions, one with an area of 8,000 sqm (proposed Portion 21b6) and one with an area of 3,360 sqm (proposed Portion 21b5). The area of proposed Portion 21b5 would be less than the minimum lot size of 8,000 sqm specified for the Rural Residential zone in the Norfolk Island Plan 2002; and so the proposed subdivision is currently a prohibited use or development. The Plan Variation Application proposes to reclassify the proposed subdivision of Portion 21b2, as described above, from prohibited use or development to permissible with consent use or development, to allow the Development Application for this subdivision to be considered and determined.

The aim and intent of this draft plan is to allow Portion 21b2 to be subdivided into two portions as described above. Details of the draft plan and reasons for the application are available for inspection, during business hours, at the Planning Office at the Administration of Norfolk Island, New Military Barracks, Kingston.

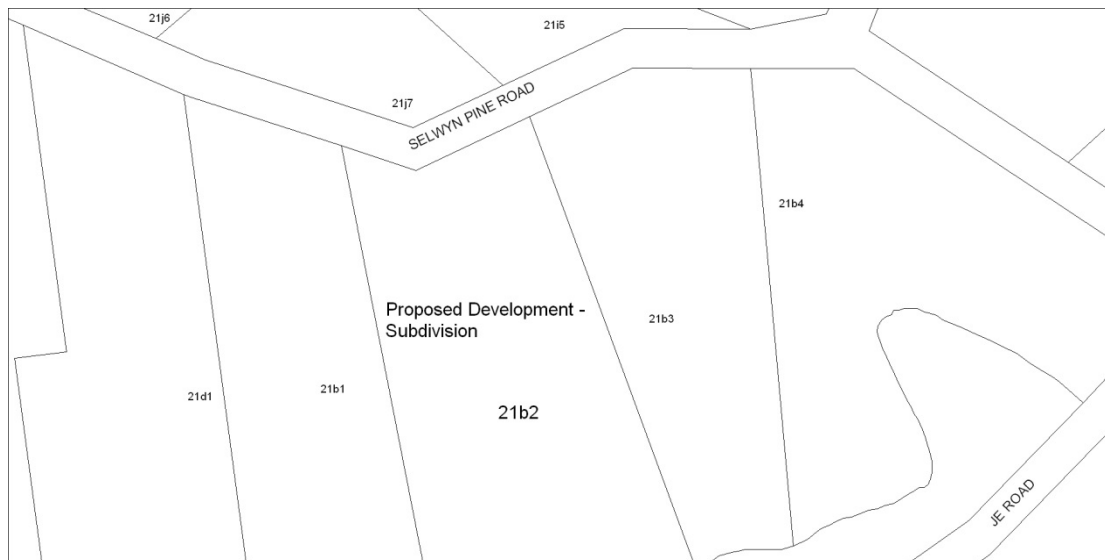
