BAY STREET ROAD BRIDGE CLOSURE

An Engineer's report has identified serious structural defects with the Bay Street Bridge that is within KAVHA, accordingly for public safety the Bay Street Bridge will be closed immediately

The closure will be for at least a 2 month period depending on the supply and delivery of material necessary for the repair works to be completed.

While access for emergency vehicles will be provided via alternative access, the public will need to park at the Lime Kiln or along Slaughter Bay until the repairs have been completed.

While we understand this is a disruption to public and tourist access via the Bay Street Bridge the safety to the public is of our paramount concern.

Every effort will be made to ensure the closure of the Bridge is as minimal as possible.

PUBLIC RESERVES ACT 1997

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDGE IN POINT HUNTER RESERVE

I, Peter Martin Davidson, Conservator of Public Reserves, under section 34 of the *Public Reserves Act 1997*, declare closed that part of Point Hunter Reserve in which the road bridge near the Lime Kiln is situated as I believe on reasonable grounds that it is necessary to do so in order to protect public safety, and declare the bridge access to be closed to the public from the date of gazettal of this notice until this declaration is revoked or a period not exceeding two months whichever is the lesser.
