PUBLIC RESERVES ACT 1997

DECLARATION OF TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BRIDGE IN POINT HUNTER RESERVE

I, Peter Martin Davidson, Conservator of Public Reserves, under section 34 of the *Public Reserves Act 1997*, revoke any previous declaration of closure of that part of the Point Hunter Reserve comprising the bridge near the Lime Kiln and declare closed that part of Point Hunter Reserve in which the road bridge near the Lime Kiln is situated including the road bridge itself as I believe on reasonable grounds that it is necessary to do so in order to protect public safety, and declare the bridge access to be closed to the public from the date of gazettal of this notice until this declaration is revoked or a period not exceeding two months whichever is the lesser.

CUSTOMS & IMMIGRATION SERVICES CHANGE TO WORKING ARRANGEMENTS

The public are advised that there have been some changes to the working arrangements for the Customs operation of the Customs & Immigration Services.

As from and including Friday 14 August 2015 and until further notice the office will remain open until 5.00 pm on Friday afternoons. This change is to allow consignees with air freight that arrived on a Friday flight to complete any Customs formalities and collect the release slip for the air freight from the Customs Office.

Closure of the office on other days of the week will remain at 4.00 pm.

The office will be closed on weekends from and including Saturday 15 August until further notice. On those weekends Customs Officers will attend aircraft for passenger and air freight processing. Perishable goods and any consignment needed for an emergency situation that arrives on the weekend will be processed for collection on the day of arrival. Other air freight that arrives on the weekend will be ready for completion of Customs formalities on the following Monday.
