**INQUEST INTO THE MANNER AND CAUSE OF DEATH OF KERRI ELIZABETH HAMILTON-IRVINE WHO DIED ON THE 9 DECEMBER 2014**

That the Deputy Coroner, Mr David Rodgers, at an Inquest held on 17 November 2015 in Norfolk Island found as follows:

At some time between 4.00 pm and 4.30 pm on Tuesday, 9 December 2014 at 9 Cutters Corn Road, Norfolk Island, a person identified as Kerri Elizabeth Hamilton-Irvine and who was aged 50 years, died from the effects of a gunshot wound to her chest, self-inflicted, with the intention of taking her own life.

The Deputy Coroner noted and made recommendations concerning the possible improvement of current firearms legislation as well as the importance of adequate and appropriate steps being taken by all persons to properly secure and store firearms in every situation.

The Deputy Coroner published his full findings and recommendations in the Court and extended his condolences to the family and extended his thanks to the police for their thorough investigation.

**INQUEST INTO THE MANNER AND CAUSE OF DEATH OF HERMANSYAH AKBAR WHO DIED ON OR ABOUT 27 OR 28 APRIL 2015**

That the Deputy Coroner, Mr David Rodgers, at an Inquest held on 17 November 2015 in Norfolk Island found as follows:

That at some time between about 9.00 pm on Monday 27 April 2015 to 8.15 am on Tuesday 28 April 2015 in Room 214 at the Castaway Hotel, Taylors Road, Norfolk Island Hermansyah Akbar ("the deceased") died suddenly and unexpectedly of the effects of natural causes but what the particulars of such natural causes or as to the manner of death are or whether such natural causes involved the effects of chronic asthma, a pulmonary oedema, a cardiac arrhythmia, a seizure or metabolic disorder or a biochemical derangement, the evidence adduced does not enable me to say.

The Deputy Coroner noted and made recommendations concerning the importance of adequate and appropriate travel insurance in reducing or meeting the cost of retrieval of a loved one's body across international borders or long distances and extended his thanks to the police for their thorough investigation, to Mr Herfino, Vice-Consul of the Consulate-General of Indonesia in Sydney and to Mr Mohammad (Imran) Ali of Norfolk Island for their valuable assistance and advice regarding cultural matters to be observed before, during and after the autopsy as well as extending the Court's condolences to the deceased's family in Indonesia.

**DOGS REGISTRATION ACT 1936**

The public are reminded that dog registrations expire on the 1 January 2016 and that the keeping of an unregistered dog is an offence.

It is the responsibility of the owner/keeper to ensure that any dog over the age of 6 months is registered and wearing a current registration tag issued by the Registrar of Dogs.

Owners or dogs are therefore encouraged to ensure that their dog is registered and that the identification tag is affixed to the dog within 14 days after it has been issued.
