DOGS REGISTRATION ACT 1936

The public are reminded that dog registrations expire on the 1 January 2016 and that the keeping of an unregistered dog is an offence.

It is the responsibility of the owner/keeper to ensure that any dog over the age of 6 months is registered and wearing a current registration tag issued by the Registrar of Dogs.

Owners or dogs are therefore encouraged to ensure that their dog is registered and that the identification tag is affixed to the dog within 14 days after it has been issued.

POINT HUNTER RESERVE
EMILY AND SLAUGHTER BAYS

For everyone's safety and enjoyment at the beach this summer, please:

- **DO NOT** walk dogs or allow dogs to roam free on Emily Bay beach, Slaughter Bay beach or in nearby picnic areas:
 - **dogs are not permitted to be seaward of Bay Street or the road that runs around the back of Emily Bay**
- **DO NOT drive into areas in which motor vehicles (including motor bikes) are prohibited:**
 - any area defined by timber vehicle control fences or log barriers, in particular
 - the Salt House area
 - the grassed area east of the creek (in which Se Moosa Bus sets up)
 - the ridge at Point Hunter ("Chinaman's")
 - Emily Bay beach or sand dunes
 - pasture areas on the Common; and
 - the main (western) Government House drive
- **DO NOT** light fires on or near Emily Bay beach or other than in a fireplace or portable gas barbecue or stove; and
- **DO NOT** litter
 - including smashing bottles on or near the beach.

Each of these activities carries a fine of up to \$1,000 (*Public Reserves Act 1997*).

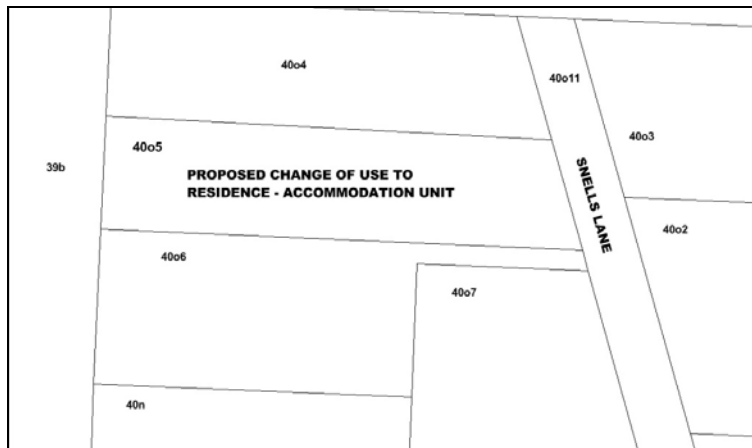
