

MARINE SAFETY (AMENDMENT) BILL 2013

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

This Bill corrects two omissions in the principal Act.

The opening clauses provide for the short title, the commencement (and that the Bill has effect from the commencement of the principal Act), and the name of the Act being amended.

Clause 4 makes the required corrections—

subclause (1) inserts a missing word —“is”; and

subclause (2) inserts the phrase “, or of another country prescribed by regulation,” in order to ensure that licences issued in places such as New Zealand may be recognised.
