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EXPLANATORY NOTES

Historical

Norfolk Island became a Territory under the authority of the Commonwealth of Australia on 1 July 1914. Before that date the affairs of the Island were administered by the Governor of the State of New South Wales in accordance with an Imperial Order-in-Council dated 18 October 1900. Under the powers conferred by that Order-in-Council the Governor of the State of New South Wales on 23 December 1913 made a proclamation repealing all laws previously in force in Norfolk Island and enacting 32 new laws. The new laws were expressed by the proclamation to come into force on the date of publication of the proclamation, which was 24 December 1913. These Tables accordingly give particulars of the statute law of Norfolk Island from 24 December 1913.

Publication details

Previous issues of these Tables have been published, stating the law as at 31 July 1985 and thereafter annually or when deemed necessary. They are now published electronically and updated every couple of months.

The Norfolk Island Government Gazette should be consulted for changes made after the operative date of this issue.

Citation of Laws Act 1995

The *Citation of Laws Act 1995* came into operation on 1 January 1996. The effect of the Act was to change the title of all pre self-government laws from “Ordinance” to “Act” and to consequentially amend all references to Ordinances.

Interpretation Act 1979

The *Interpretation Act 1979* provides references for common words and expressions used in Norfolk Island legislation. The *Territories Law Reform Act 2010* (Commonwealth) changed some expressions defined in the *Norfolk Island Act 1979* (Commonwealth) and in the *Interpretation Act 1979* including references to Minister and executive member - the changes took effect from the commencement of the *Territories Law Reform Act 2010*. The *Interpretation (Amendment) Act 2012* amended the principal Act to make it consistent with the changes in the *Territories Law Reform Act 2010* and it also amended the *Enactments Reprinting Act 1980* to make it clear that the authority to correct legislation upon reprinting and consolidation, extends to changing the references to “executive member” and “Minister”.

Notes to Alphabetical Table of legislation

The Alphabetical Table of legislation gives particulars of enactments and subordinate legislation of which at least a part was in force on 15 January 2015. Uncommenced sections of legislation are referred to in the list of Enactments not Commenced.

A reference to a consolidation of a law is a reference to that law as consolidated in the pamphlet consolidation series issued under the authority of the *Enactments Reprinting Act 1980*. Only subsequent amendments are shown. Details of the previous legislative history of the law concerned may be found in the Notes contained in the pamphlet consolidation of that law.

Past practice referred to Norfolk Island consolidated legislation as Reprinted. A policy decision has been made to modernise this reference in line with legislation consolidated in other jurisdictions. Legislation consolidated is noted in these tables as Consolidated.

Notes to Chronological Table of enactments

The Chronological Table of enactments gives particulars of enactments (Laws, Ordinances and Acts) from 24 December 1913 to 15 January 2015. Enactments that have been repealed are marked "Repealed". The year and number of the repealing enactment is given. Enactments that have no continued application because of the passage of time are marked "Spent".

Notes to Chronological Table of Regulations, rules and bylaws

The Chronological Table of regulations, rules and bylaws gives particulars of subordinate legislation made from 24 December 1913 to 15 January 2015 under the authority of an enactment. Some details are given as to whether an item has been repealed, or is spent. All subordinate legislation currently in force is listed opposite to the citation of the parent enactment in the Alphabetical Table of legislation.
