Interpretation (Amendment) Act 1982

Act No. 8 of 1982

An Act to amend the *Interpretation Act 1979*

[Reserved for assent on 5 March 1982]

[Assented to 19 June 1982]

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island as follows —

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Interpretation (Amendment) Act 1982*.

Commencement

2. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on 11 February 1982.

Interpretation

3. In this Act “the Principal Act” means the *Interpretation Act 1979*.

General definitions (Amendment of section 12)

4. Section 12 of the Principal Act is amended by omitting the definition of “Chief Minister” and “Deputy Chief Minister”.

References to executive members (Amendment of section 14A)

5. Section 14A of the Principal Act is amended by omitting subsection (2).
