An Act  
to amend the *Standard Time and Daylight Saving Act 1974*

WHEREAS it appears to me Sir John Robert Kerr, the Governor-General of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, that the following Act should, on account of urgency, be made without the proposed Act being first submitted to the Norfolk Island Council:

NOW THEREFORE I, the Governor-General of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, hereby make the following Act under the *Norfolk Island Act 1957-1973*.

### **Short title and citation**

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Standard Time and Daylight Saving Act (No. 2) 1974*.
- (2) The *Standard Time and Daylight Saving Act 1974* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.
- (3) The Principal Act, as amended by this Act, may be cited as the *Standard Time and Daylight Saving Act 1974*.

### **Termination of summer time**

2. The Principal Act is amended by omitting from the definition of "the daylight saving period" in section 3 the word and figures "23 March 1975" and substituting the word and figures "2 March 1975".
