Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Act 1985

Act No. 13 of 1986

An Act to amend the *Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1971*

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island as follows —

[Assented to 8 May 1986]

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Act 1985*.

Principal Act

2. The *Law reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Act 1985* is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Damages in actions which survive under this Part

3. Section 5 of the Principal Act is amended —

(a) by omitting from subparagraph (c)(i) “and”; and

(b) by adding at the end of paragraph (c) the following —

“; and (iii) do not include damages for the loss of the capacity of that person to earn, or for the loss of future probable earnings of that person, had he survived.”.

Application

4. (1) Subject to subsection (2), the Principal Act as amended by this Act applies in relation to a cause of action whether the cause of action arose before or after the commencement of this Act.

(2) The Principal Act as amended by this Act does not apply in relation to a cause of action in respect of which judgment has before the commencement of this Act, been given or entered, whether or not an appeal has been made against that judgment.
