## REGISTRATION OF BULLS AMENDMENT ACT 1987

Act No 18 of 1987

---

An Act to amend the Registration of Bulls Ordinance 1937

[Assented to 28 October 1987]

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island as follows -

### Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Registration of Bulls Amendment Act 1987.

### Principal Ordinance

2. The Registration of Bulls Ordinance 1937 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

### New section

3. The Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after section 10 the following:

#### Exemptions

"10A. (1) A bull may be -

(a) transported in a vehicle; or

(b) moved by a person by another method by the shortest practicable route,

between the property of the owner or person holding the certificate of the bull and another place where the bull is confined so as to prevent damage being done by it to neighbouring stock or property.

(2) The executive member may permit a specified bull to be at large on unenclosed land.

(3) A bull referred to in subsection (2) is subject to the supervision and control of the Administration.

- (4) This section applies notwithstanding -
- (a) another provision of this Ordinance;  
or
  - (b) a provision of another enactment."

**Exemption from liability**

4. Section 11 of the Principal Ordinance is amended -

- (a) by omitting "an inspector" and substituting "the Administration, the executive member or an inspector"; and
- (b) by omitting "the inspector or the Administration" and substituting "the Administration, the executive member or the inspector".
