**DOGS REGISTRATION AMENDMENT ACT 1988**

**Act No 7 of 1988**

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An Act to amend the Dogs Registration Ordinance 1936

[Assented to 18 May 1988]

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Legislative Assembly of Norfolk Island as follows -

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Dogs Registration Amendment Act 1988.

**Principal Ordinance**

2. The Dogs Registration Ordinance 1936 is in this Act referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

**Definitions**

3. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting after the definition of "certificate" in subsection (1) -

"'designated foreshore' means an area of land specified in an instrument in force under section 17;".

**Unregistered dogs may be seized**

4. Section 13 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "any unregistered dog" and substituting "an unregistered dog or a dog, whether or not registered, found on a designated foreshore".

**New section**

5. The Principal Ordinance is amended by adding at the end -

**Dogs on foreshores**

"17. (1) The executive member may, by instrument in writing published in the Gazette, specify as a designated foreshore an area of land that is within the area specified in the Schedule.

(2) A keeper of a dog shall not allow the dog to go onto a designated foreshore.

Penalty for an offence  
against this subsection: 2 penalty units.

**SCHEDULE****Section 17**

The area of land bounded by a line commencing at low water mark immediately adjacent to the southeastern side of Kingston Pier; thence generally easterly, southerly, easterly, northeasterly, southeasterly, southwesterly, easterly, northeasterly, northerly and northeasterly following the coast at low water mark to the intersection of the southeasterly prolongation of the western boundary of portion 67c; thence northwesterly by that prolongation to a point on the southern boundary of Driver Christian Road; thence generally westerly by the southern boundary of that Road for 200 metres; thence generally southwesterly, southerly, southwesterly, westerly, northeasterly, northwesterly, southwesterly, westerly, northerly and westerly parallel to the coast at low water mark to a point on the eastern boundary of Pier Street; thence generally southwesterly by the eastern, southern and eastern boundary of Pier Street to the southern extremity of that Street; thence generally southwesterly in a straight line to the point of commencement."
