TIP
Remove all lids from your empty glass bottles and jars before recycling

REMEMBER
Do not place plastic bags or cardboard boxes in the recyclable chutes
Only place clean, empty cans and glass bottles in the recycling chutes

WHAT IS CHANGING AT THE WASTE MANAGEMENT CENTRE?

The community should be aware that fees will be charged on non-recyclable waste deposited at the Waste Management Centre and Headstone Disposal Centre as of the 1st of August 2017. **RECYCLABLE ITEMS ARE FREE TO DISPOSE.** If recyclable materials are separated before they are brought into the Waste Management Centre your cost of disposal will be reduced. Please refer to the list on the next page of recyclable and non-recyclable items.
