NEW LOGO REQUIRED FOR THE NORFOLK ISLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL

A new logo is required for the new Norfolk Island Regional Council. It is important that the logo represent the Norfolk Island community as Council is in place to serve its community. As such, the Councillors and General Manager would like to invite interested persons to submit logo designs for the Norfolk Island Regional Council.

‘We want to ensure that everyone has the opportunity to submit logo ideas. We acknowledge that some people will be able to submit a digitised logo, however, for those that can’t we would also like to accept sketches from interested persons. If a sketch was selected, the Council would work with a graphic designer to digitise the logo,’ Ms Lotta Jackson said.

‘Whilst there will be a small prize given to the successful logo designer, the designer will be remembered in Norfolk Island history as the creator of a prestigious logo that will be widely-circulated,’ Mayor Adams said.

‘There are some limitations on the logo design in that we need to be able to use it on business cards as well as large banners but apart from that, we are excited to see what designs will come forth. Logos should be submitted to Gaye Evans, New Military Barracks, Kingston or via email to gaye.evans@nirc.gov.nf no later than 4.30pm on 1 August 2016,’ Ms Lotta Jackson said.

The Councillors will assess and then decide on the logo for the Norfolk Island Regional Council. The Council reserves the right to slightly amend the final logo design if required and will do this in consultation with the designer to ensure the integrity of the design.
