For those still wishing to submit a logo, a recap of the 15 July 2016 media release is below:

- it is important that the logo represent the Norfolk Island community as Council is in place to serve its community
- the design needs to consider that the logo will be used on business cards as well as large banners, but apart from that there are no limitations on the designs that can be submitted
- for those that can't submit a digitised logo, sketches will be accepted and Council will work with a graphic designer to digitise the sketch
- Councillors will assess and then decide on the logo for the Norfolk Island Regional Council. Council reserves the right to slightly amend the final logo design if required and will do this in consultation with the designer to ensure the integrity of the design
- a small prize will be given to the successful logo designer
