VISIT OF GAI BRODTMANN MP

Council and the Executive Management team will be meeting informally with Ms Brodtmann this Saturday, 3 September 2016. 'We will be discussing matters of mutual concern relating to Norfolk Island. Ms Brodtmann will be accompanied by Ms Alicia Turner who is Ms Brodtmann's Electorate Officer. I will report on our discussions on next Wednesday's radio chat', Mayor Adams said.

Early Education and Child Care Services

'As I said on radio on Wednesday I am grateful to Ms Rosie Batty during her meeting with Councillors for raising the question of early education and child care services and how we might provide these services into the future. Council has already received a comprehensive submission from one of the current service providers on how the Council could address this issue. So to start that conversation I will be contacting the Principal and the current Directors of each of the child care services on the Island to meet with me late next week. This will allow us to start a conversation on how best Norfolk can cater for our pre-schoolers going forward into the future. This is an issue I will also be raising with Ms Brodtmann when we meet this weekend', Mayor Adams said.
