COUNCIL MEETING 19 NOVEMBER

An Ordinary Council Meeting will be held on Wednesday, 19 November 2016 at 2:00pm in the Council Chambers located in the Bicentennial Complex. The public are welcome to attend.

Agenda items for this week include the first Operational Plan Quarterly Review July to September. Some of the achievements to date include: review commenced for the supply of electricity; destination marketing and tourism activities supported and enhanced; developed waste management initiatives to reduce waste; Council Customer Service team aim for high standard with continuous improvement practices; Airport challenges are being addressed; Civica Project (organisational wide software) commenced and full steam ahead; framework for Governance established; and development of log of claims for an Enterprise Agreement.

The September Quarterly Budget Review Statement will be presented to Council and a recommendation made for Council to adopt the recommendations in the Statement.

The quarterly budget review process is the mechanism through which Council and the community are informed of Council's progress against the Operational Plan (annual budget), together with recommendations for changes and reasons for any budget variations.
