Travel restrictions from Victoria removed from Monday November 23rd 2020.

Travellers from Victoria (both Metropolitan and Regional) will be allowed to come to the island without having to undergo local quarantine from Monday November 23rd. The removal of the quarantine requirement corresponds to the proposed reopening of the Victorian/New South Wales border that was announced yesterday. The removal of the requirement is based upon continuing low levels of community transmission in Victoria.

Updated bus requirements

EMT has been asked to reconsider the density requirements for buses, particularly the smaller buses used for progressive dinners and other access dependent tours.

Removal of the current density limitations on these buses undertaking tours on the island, has been agreed, however all passengers must wear a face mask at all times whilst on board. This requirement is compulsory whilst on the bus and any passenger refusing to wear a mask, will not be carried.

Other COVID safe requirements such as passenger manifests, the driver wearing Personal Protective Equipment, bus cleaning and hygiene requirements remain.
