### *Travelling to Norfolk Island from South Australia*

As there have been no new cases in South Australia we will allow travellers from South Australia to travel to Norfolk Island with no quarantine requirements, effective immediately.

### *Travelling to Norfolk Island from Victoria*

Quarantine requirements for travellers from Victoria was removed this week on Monday 23 November 2020.

### *Contact tracing registers*

We remind businesses that they are required to maintain a contact register that includes anyone who spends more than 15 minutes in your business and keep it for a period of 3 months for contact tracing purposes. This includes staff, guests, members, trades persons, cleaners etc.

### *COVID-19 symptoms*

Symptoms of COVID-19:

- fever (37.5 ° or higher)
- sore/scratchy throat
- shortness of breath
- runny nose
- loss of smell/taste
- cough

What to do if you have any symptoms:

- stay at home and away from others
- contact NIHRACS on +6723 22091
- don't go to work
- get tested and wait for results before returning to work
