### ***NSW Travellers***

**The New South Wales Government has issued travel restrictions in respect of the Northern Beaches LGA that apply until midnight on Wednesday 23 December 2020.**

Taking a holiday outside the Northern Beaches is not regarded as a reasonable excuse for leaving your home. Therefore if you reside in the Northern Beaches LGA or have been to any of the locations listed at <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latest-news-and-updates#latest-covid-19-case-locations-in-nsw> which require self-isolation and getting tested you should not travel to Norfolk Island. Doing so will be in breach of the NSW Public Health order and you may be returned or referred to NSW authorities for action.

Returning residents and essential personnel maybe allowed entry but will be required to undertake self-isolation at their residence or if this is not possible in private accommodation at their own cost. Currently the medical requirement is for self-isolation for 14 days.

Currently this restriction applies to the Northern Beaches LGA however the Government has indicated that residents of the greater Sydney should limit unnecessary activity and has reintroduced some restrictions. The situation will be monitored daily and EMT will inform the community via Social Media and the NIRC website of changes over the holiday period.
