### **Update December 23<sup>rd</sup> TRAVELLING TO NORFOLK ISLAND FROM NSW**

Following today's announcement by the New South Wales Premier, it has been decided that restrictions in respect to travellers from NSW will remain in place.

Travellers from the following Greater Sydney, Central Coast and Wollongong Local Government Areas are encouraged not to travel to the island and will be required to undertake 14 days quarantine:

Bayside, Blacktown, Blue Mountains, Burwood, Camden, Campbelltown, Canada Bay, Canterbury-Bankstown, Central Coast, Cumberland, Fairfield, Georges River, Hawkesbury, The Hills Shire, Hornsby, Hunter's Hill, Inner West, Ku-ring-gai, Lane Cove, Liverpool, Mosman, North Sydney, Parramatta, Penrith, Randwick, Ryde, Strathfield, Sutherland Shire, Sydney, Waverley, Willoughby, Wollondilly, Wollongong, Woollahra.

Travellers (including Norfolk Island residents) from the Northern Beaches LGA will not be allowed entry to the island.

Travellers from Regional NSW areas not subject to restriction and travellers transiting through Sydney Airport from other States and Territories are allowed to travel to the island and will not have to undergo quarantine.

If returning residents and essential workers are undergoing quarantine in a household, all other members of the household are also required to quarantine.

EMT will continue to monitor the situation and will remove these requirements as soon as it is safe to do so.
