All potential travellers are required to follow the advice given by their State or Territory and follow instructions relating to case locations or public exposure sites. Travel to the island should be delayed until any instructions associated with these listings have been fulfilled.

TRAVELLING TO NORFOLK ISLAND FROM NSW

People wanting to travel from the hot spot covering the northern area of the Northern Beaches LGA in NSW are currently not permitted to travel to Norfolk Island. A map of the area and a list of suburbs can be found at: <https://www.nsw.gov.au/covid-19/what-you-can-and-cant-do-under-rules/northern-beaches#map-of-northern-beaches-areas>. The southern region of the LGA is no longer regarded as a hot spot.

Those travelling from the Greater Sydney Area, Wollongong and the Central Coast, including those from the southern area of the Northern Beaches LGA are permitted to travel and will be required to undertake 14 days self-isolation at their own expense.

Travellers from Regional NSW are not required to self-isolate on arrival, provided that they have travelled directly to the airport, or overnighed in an airport hotel. Regional travellers may travel to the airport via public transport, if they travel directly to the airport or airport hotel. Transport directly to the airport by car is recommended. NSW requirements associated with wearing a face mask whilst using public transport must be followed.

TRAVELLING TO NORFOLK ISLAND FROM VICTORIA

There are no current restrictions on travel to the island from Victoria. Travellers from the Greater Melbourne Area may be required to have a test on arrival and isolate until they receive a negative result if they have not done so prior to travel.

TRAVELLING TO NORFOLK ISLAND FROM OTHER STATES AND TERRITORIES

Travellers from other States and Territories are not required to undertake self isolation. Those transiting through Sydney Airport may stay overnight, provided that they stay at an airport hotel.
