Update Greater Brisbane 3-day lockdown and residents returning to Norfolk Island

The Queensland Government has updated overnight advice in respect to the circumstances under which people can leave Greater Brisbane during the lockdown period to include returning home if this is outside Greater Brisbane. This change will allow island residents to return home. On returning to the island returning resident's will be required to self-isolate at home until 6pm on Monday 11 January.
