Self-isolation requirement for travellers from the Greater Sydney area removed – 26 January 2021.

This morning New South Wales recorded no new cases of locally acquired COVID-19 infections. This means that there has been 14 days without community transmission in the state. On this basis the current requirement for travellers from the remaining nine LGA's of the Greater Sydney area to the island to undertake 14 days self-isolation is lifted from midnight tonight. Anybody from these LGA's currently undergoing self-isolation on the island also have the self-isolation requirement lifted.

EMT will monitor the situation with respect to the recent reported cases in New Zealand and will discuss this on Thursday.
